A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VALDEZ,
ALASKA, PROVIDING GUIDANCE TO THE CITY MANAGER FOR THE
ADMINISTRATION OF THE RV CAMPING PERMIT IN DESIGNATED
CITY-CONTROLLED AREAS

WHEREAS, The City of Valdez has adopted standards for recreational vehicle and tent camping within city-controlled areas in Title 10 of Valdez Municipal code; and

WHEREAS, Valdez Municipal Code Title 10 gives permitting authority for limited overnight RV parking to the City Manager or designee and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to provide additional guidance to the City Manager related to administration of the overnight parking permit, including establishing the designated areas for overnight RV camping outside of RV parks and campgrounds; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to provide for the needs of visitors to Valdez for community events and recreation, while supporting local businesses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VALDEZ, ALASKA, that

Section 1. The City Manager will permit overnight RV camping in the following city-controlled areas shown on the attached maps:

- Gold Fields
- Glacier Lake Recreation Area
- Pioneer Field Airport
- South Boat Harbor
- Valdez High School
- Hermon Hutchens Elementary School

Permits issued for the Valdez High School and Elementary School will be issued in consultation with the School District Administration for school-sponsored events.

Section 2. This resolution shall be reviewed by the City Council if 100 or more permits are issued in any one calendar year.

Section 3. City of Valdez staff will identify other city-controlled commonly used locations for RV overnight parking and erect signage notifying the public that overnight camping is not permitted in that area.
