WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) announced the 2023 Emergency Preparedness Month theme of "Take Control in 1, 2, 3" – a campaign focused on preparing older adults for disasters, specifically older adults from communities that are disproportionately impacted by the all-hazard events, that continue to threaten the nation; and
