Operating Instructions

Startup

Position machine on a firm, level surface. Before starting, ensure that the machine is properly aligned and that the operator is seated correctly. Check the oil level and the battery charge.

Emergency Stop

Push the red emergency stop button to stop the machine immediately. Release the button to restart the machine.

Platform Height and Lower

Push the up/down buttons to raise or lower the platform. The platform will stop at the selected height.

Auxiliary Functions

Push the auxiliary function buttons to operate the auxiliary functions.

AC and DC Motors

The machine is equipped with AC and DC motors. The AC motor is used for the main drive and the DC motor is used for the auxiliary functions.

Manual Lowering

In the event of a power failure, the platform can be lowered manually by turning the hand crank.

After Each Use

After each use, the operator should check the machine for any damage and ensure that it is properly stored.
