Our research shows that the City of Valdez owns certain lands adjacent to the TAPS right-ofway (ADL 63574) at the referenced locations. On behalf of its owner companies, Alyeska Pipeline Service Company submits the enclosed applications for land use permission to temporarily utilize these lands in support of the subject activities.

Neither scope of work will involve significant use of city land. At Milepost 784 in Section 34, the work focus will be on state submerged land excepted from the recent state conveyance to the City (ASCS 98-30, Plat 2016-7). At Milepost 785 in Section 33, the work will focus on state land immediately adjacent in Section 32. Alyeska is submitting applications for this work to ADNR also as well as to ADFG and the Corps of Engineers at Milepost 784. Having the permission to enter city lands as needed will help the work to be safe and efficient. Alyeska will restore any areas disturbed in accordance with its manual and procedures for erosion control and revegetation.
