WORK SESSION - FIRE STATION OPTIONS

MARCH 30, 2017

OPTION A - EXISTING STATION

- 1. Requires mold remediation
- 2. Should consider removing asbestos materials
- 3. Requires re-roofing of City Hall to eliminate water intrusion
- Recommend HVAC system be replaced/upgraded to enhance building environmental health
- 5. Finance & Capital Facilities remain at the airport
- Additional city storage needs unresolved
- 7. Yellow warehouse remains
- 8. Port Office remains
- 9. Museum expansion need unresolved
- 10. Estimated cost is \$1-2 mill
 - a. Roof for all of City Hall -\$800K
 - b. Environmental remediation \$500K
 - c. HVAC upgrades/replacement– TBD based on scope

OPTION B - NEW FIRE STATION

- 1. Enables development of a modern Fire Station
- Impact to hospital master plan requires moving proposed assisted living facility
- 3. Allows for Parks/Rec (P/R) and Building Maint (BM) use of existing fire bays for storage, so these departments will no longer occupy the yellow warehouse
- Allows for expansion of Museum Annex into unoccupied warehouse space vacated by P/R & BM
- Allows for construction of Interpretive Center over south portion of existing yellow warehouse footprint
- 6. Allows for Port Office to be constructed with Interpretive Center
- Allows for demolition of existing Port Office, opening up Kelsey Dock area for cruise traffic and community events
- 8. Capital Facilities and Finance remain at the airport
- 9. Estimated cost is \$15-20 mill
 - a. \$9-10 mill for new FS
 - Does not include cost of road to highway
 - b. \$5-10 mill for new Interpretive Center, expansion of Museum, and environmental remediation of existing FS including new City Hall roof

OPTION C - NEW PUBLIC SAFETY FACILITY

- Enables development of a modern Public Safety Facility, combining Fire and Police
- 2. Same as Option B
- 3. Same as Option B, with added storage from Police bays
- 4. Same as Option B
- 5. Same as Option B
- 6. Same as Option B
- 7. Same as Option B
- 8. Capital Facilities and Finance move back to City Hall, occupying the Police wing
- 9. Estimated cost is \$20-25 mill
 - a. \$14-15 mill for new PSF
 - b. \$5-10 mill for new
 Interpretive Center,
 expansion of Museum,
 environmental
 remediation of existing
 FS including new City Hall
 roof, and re-modeling of
 Police wing for staff
 office space
