PROJECT OVERVIEW

Valdez Fire Station 1 provides the primary response to fires and emergencies throughout the City and surrounding area. The Station is Valdez's **only public safety facility with full-time personnel**, as well as volunteer responders and a complement of emergency and fire-fighting apparatus.

- Built in 1966 to serve less than 1,000 residents
- Responds to 450 calls annually
- Undersized for modern apparatus & equipment
- Fails standard for an essential or emergency operations facility
- Insufficient to properly house, train or dispatch emergency personnel
- Lacks alerting, communication & security system
- Cannot be upgraded to achieve goals

PROJECT OBJECTIVES

- Improve response time & capabilities
- Increase on-site training of staff and volunteer emergency personnel
- Function as Emergency Operations Facility/Disaster Shelter
- Lower operating & maintenance costs
- Economical & durable design for 40+ year lifespan
- Complete construction by Fall of 2021
