Senior Center does not do only what is required. The Valdez Senior Center goes beyond the scope of the ADA and strives to accommodate individual needs.

The NTS program is a backbone program for the Valdez Senior Center. The program scope of service is core to the Center's mission, providing community support for Valdez seniors through care and services. The program is a significant source of funding for the Center, providing for direct program operations expenses, as well as contributing to indirect costs (such as insurance, contractual services, fuel, and utilities) for the operation of the organization.

The Valdez Senior Center targets its services towards seniors over the age of 60 years who indicate they are living at or below poverty level and/or to disabled individuals within the Valdez service area. To ensure we are providing services to those with the greatest economic and social need, we send out a monthly newsletter with relevant information that includes a monthly activity calendar and monthly meal calendar. Menus are also available on the counter by the front desk.

There is a good amount of information & assistance and outreach public assistance, opportunities for increased socialization and fellowship for seniors, plus the Valdez Senior Center is able to assist seniors and disabled individuals through services to remain in their homes. Currently, transportation is available for shopping, medical visits, banking, rides to the Center for activities and meals, and for home delivered meals during the week. The Valdez Senior Center is committed to meeting the needs of our clients and prepared to continue to meet emergency needs and provide transportation to meet our clients' basic living necessities. Home delivered meals are delivered 365 days per year so no senior or disabled individual will go without a meal.

The social and geographical isolation that can occur for seniors and disabled people living in the outlying areas of Valdez may result in restrictions that can impact an individual's ability to perform their normal daily living tasks and hinder their capacity to live independently. The Valdez Senior Center Home Delivered Meals program is able to reach and serve these individuals and inform the Valdez Senior Center of any unusual circumstances or noticeable issues, bu conducting an informal wellness check with delivery of meals. Regular updates are received by the driver about our consumers in order for assistance to be provided by the Valdez Senior Center if necessary.

Due to the relatively small size of the community, the word about availability of services is readily spread via word of mouth, local radio announcements, flyers, newsletters, newspapers, etc. The Valdez Senior Center does not turn away any individual who is in need of meals and/or support services, and does not prescribe to a service wait list policy.
