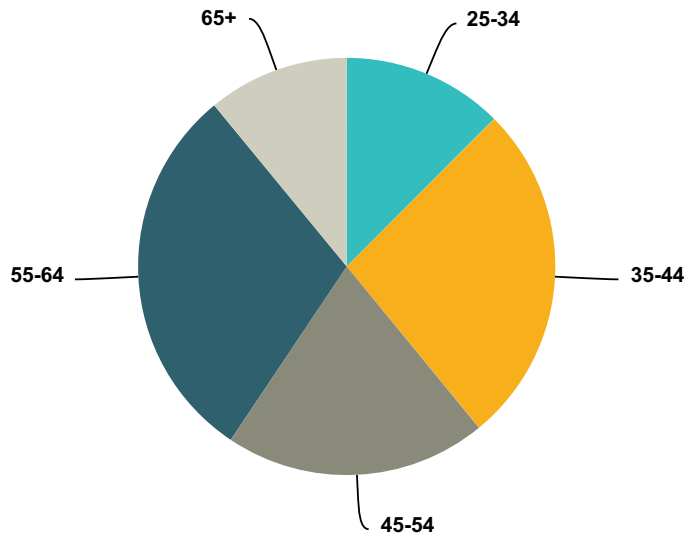

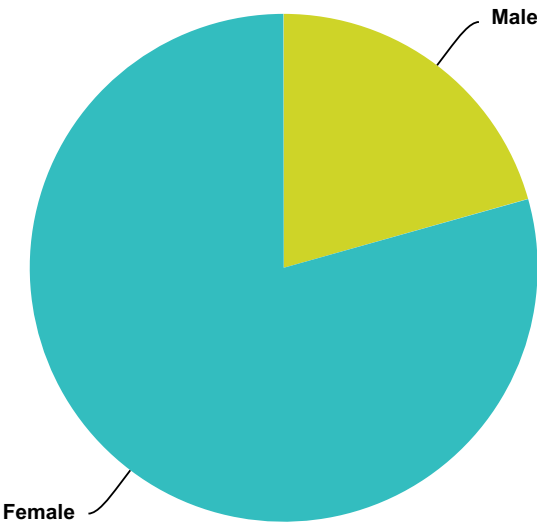

Q2 What is your gender?

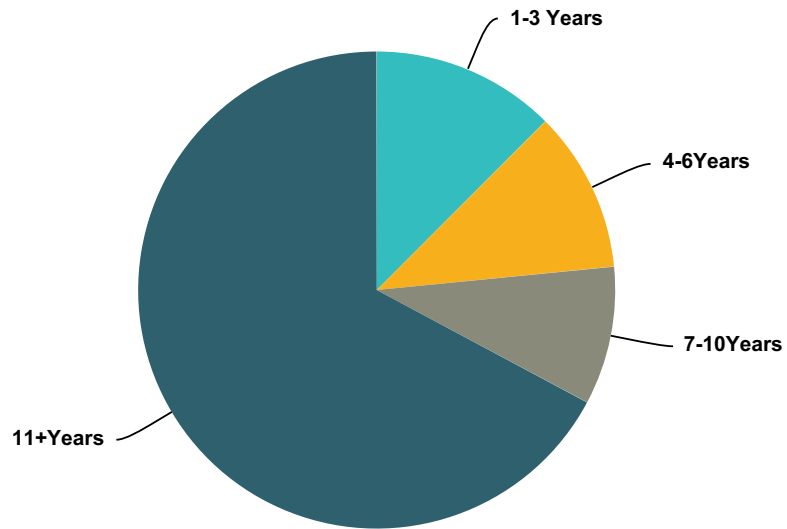

### Q3 How long have you been a resident of Valdez?

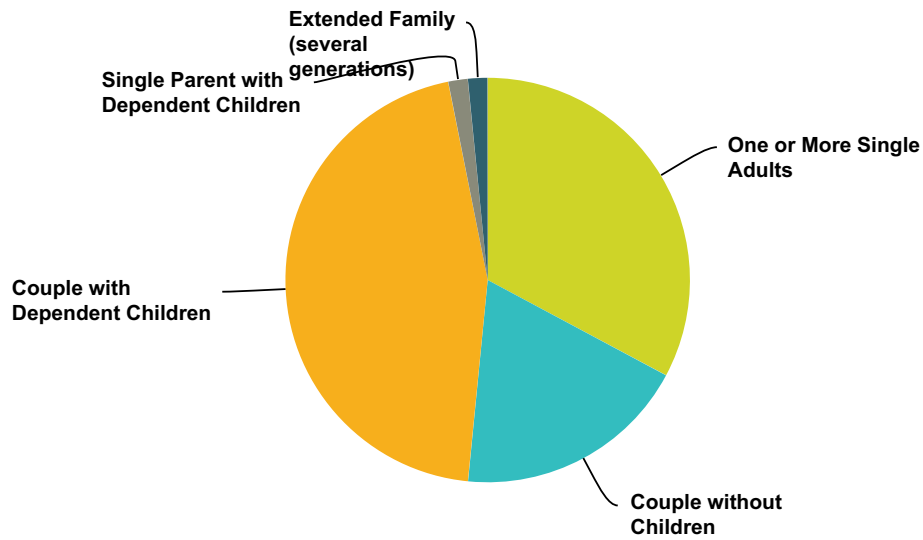

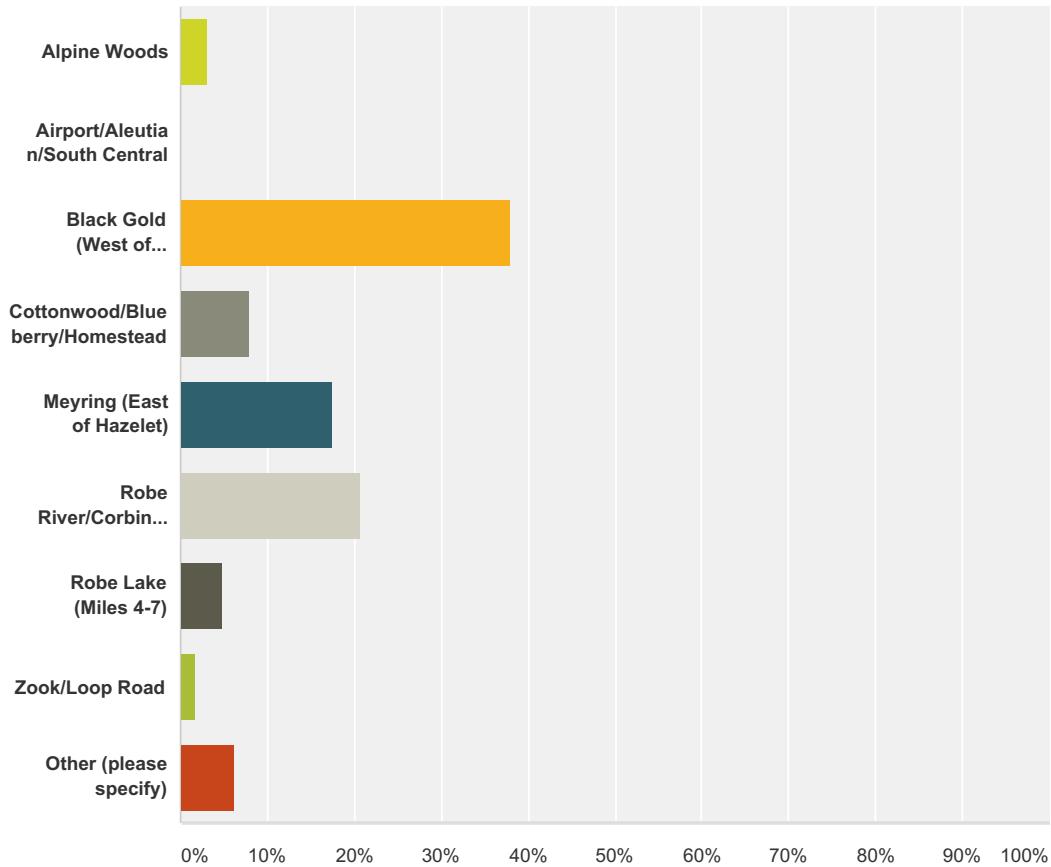

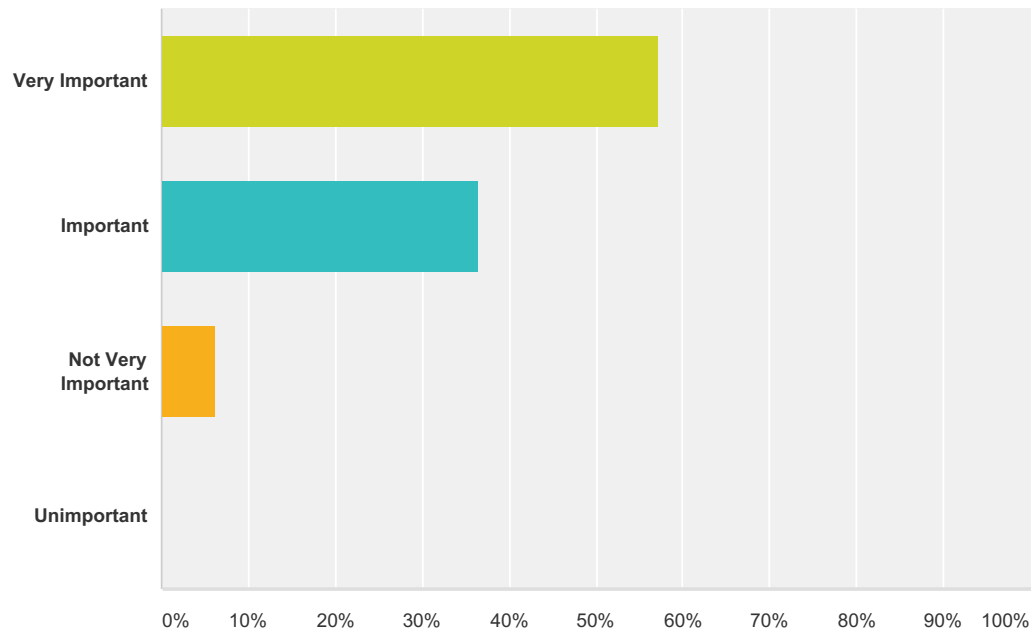

## Q6 How important are recreational and wellness activities to your lifestyle?

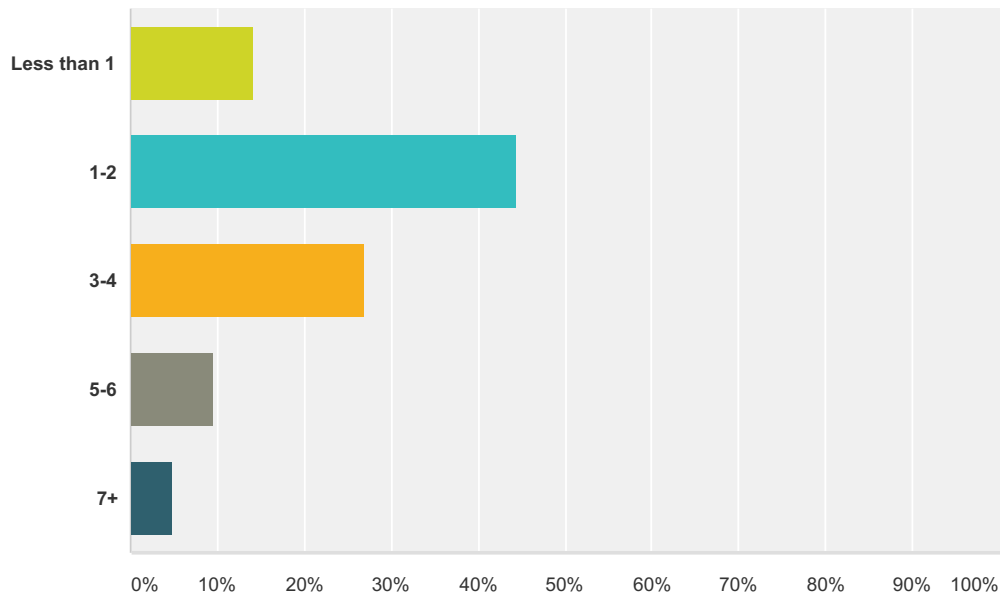

## Q7 During a week day, how many hours do you participate in recreational activities?

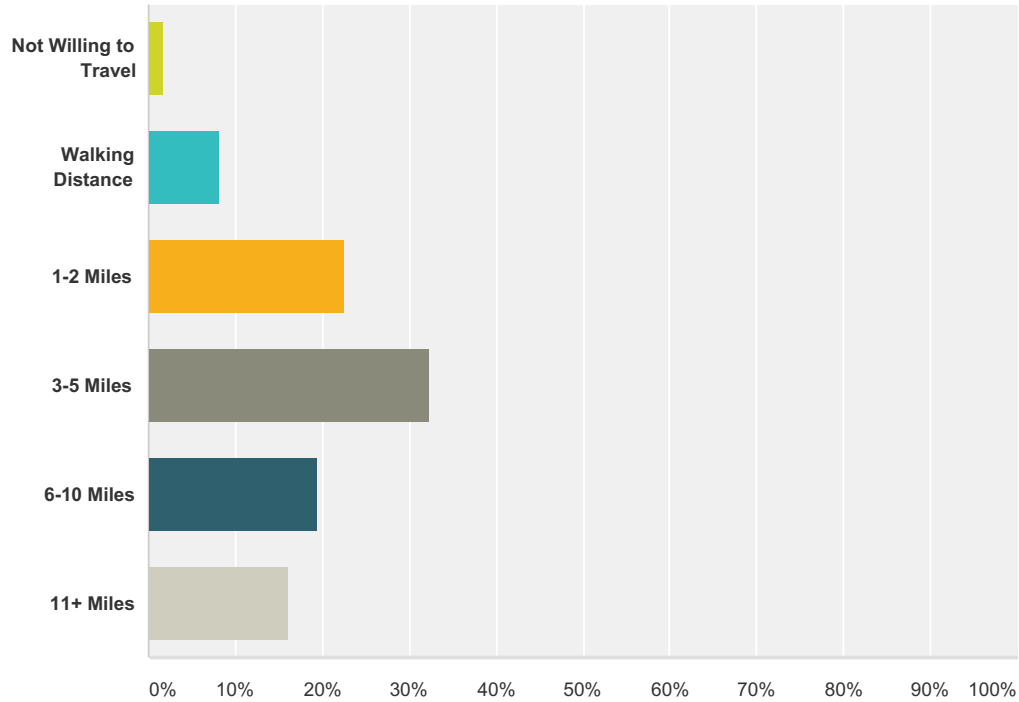

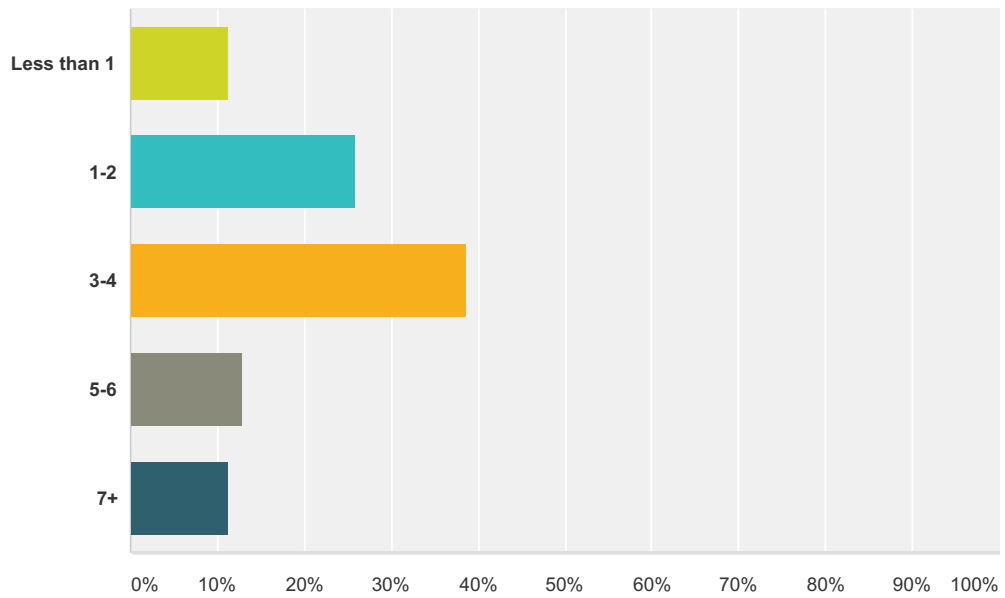

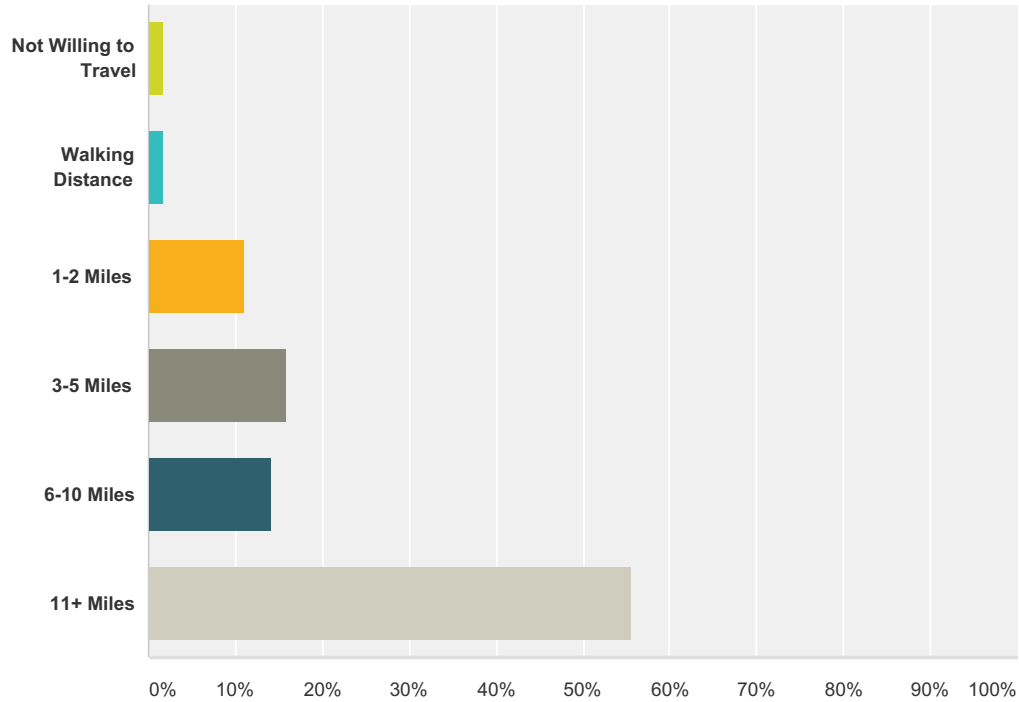

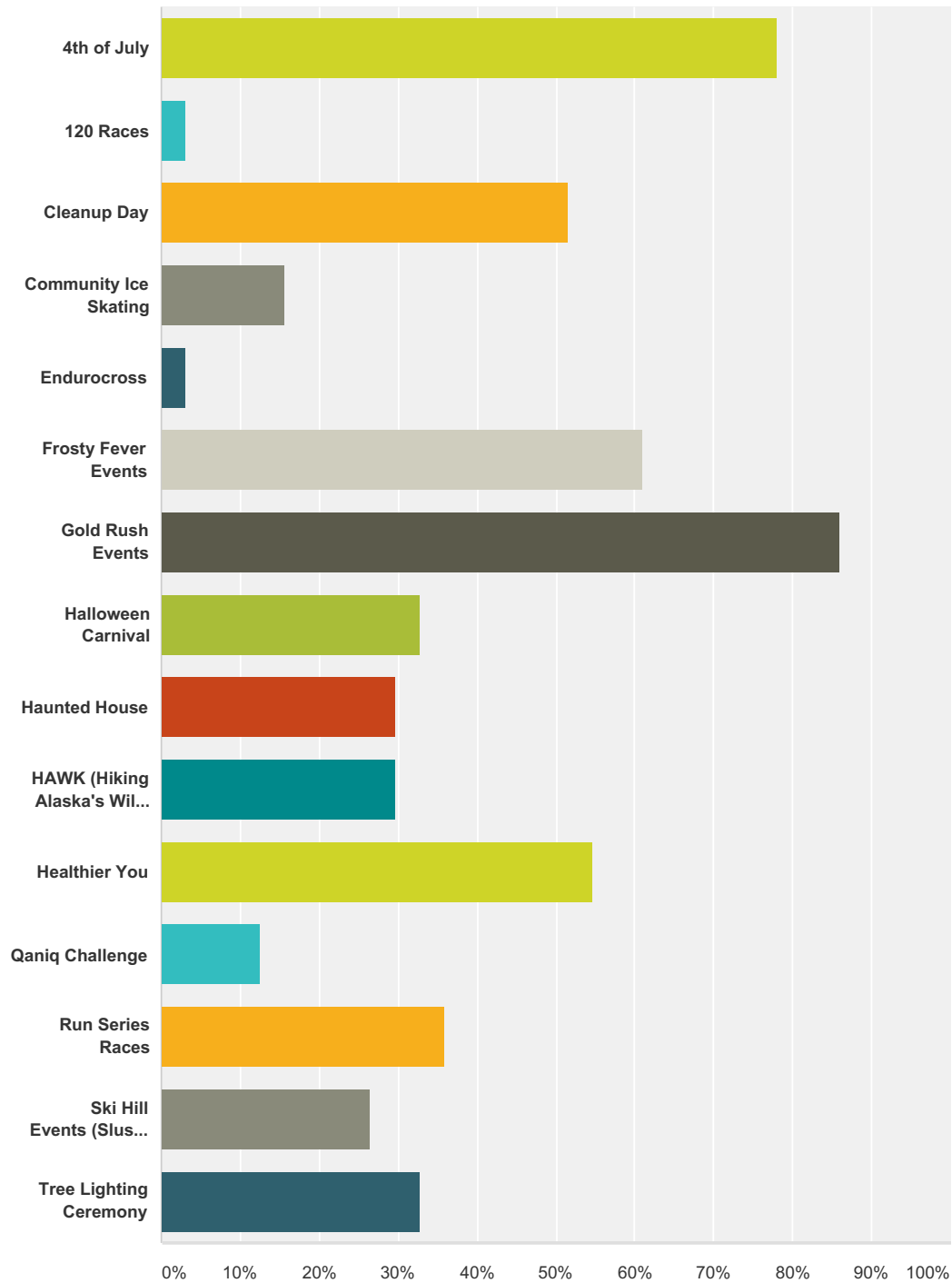

**Q25 Which of the following Parks & Recreation maintained trails have you and/or your family used within the past year?**

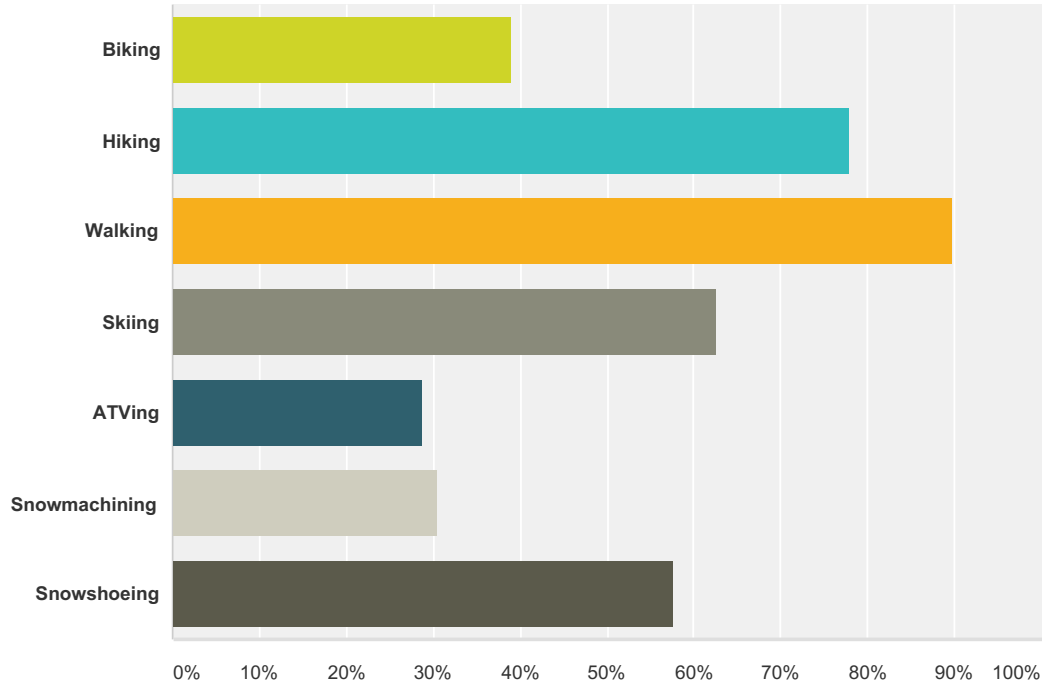

**Q26 Which of the following activities did you and/or your family partake in on the Parks & Recreation maintained trails?**

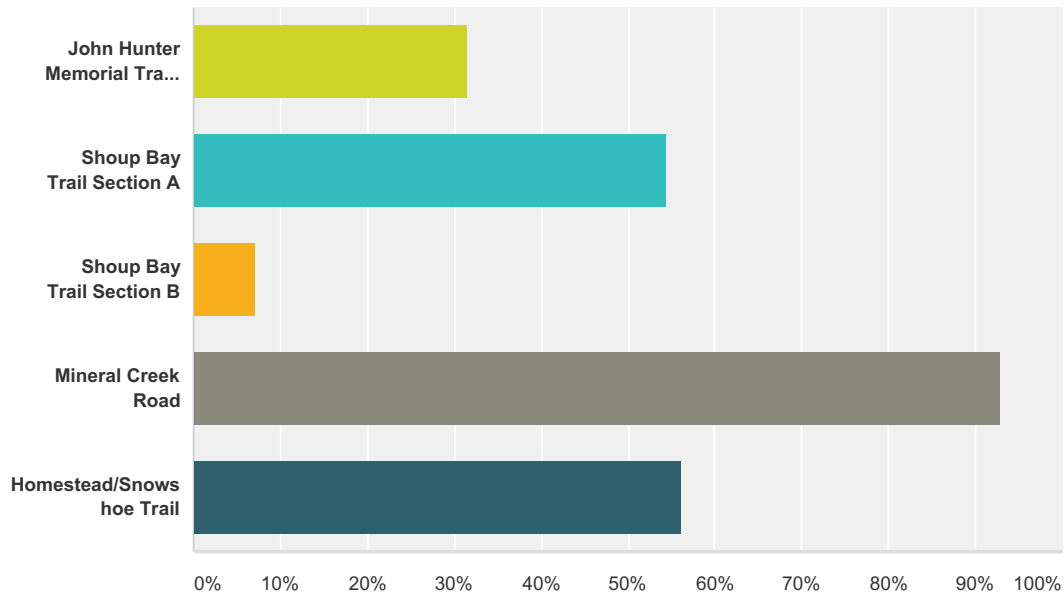

**Q27 Which of the following State of Alaska or D.O.T. maintained trails have you and/or your family used within the past year?**

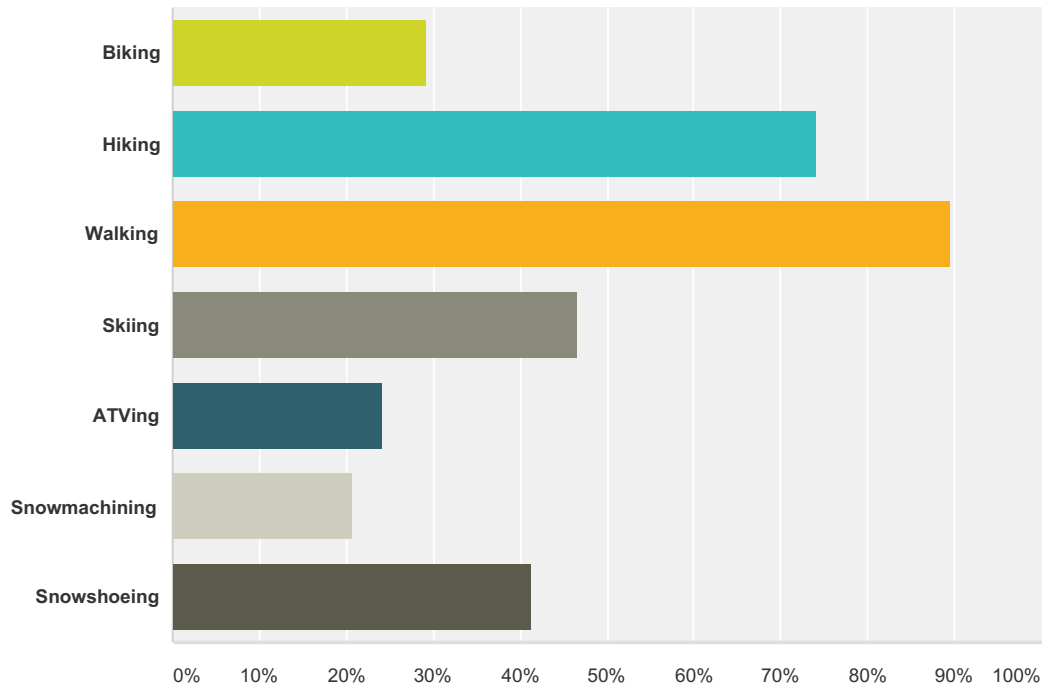

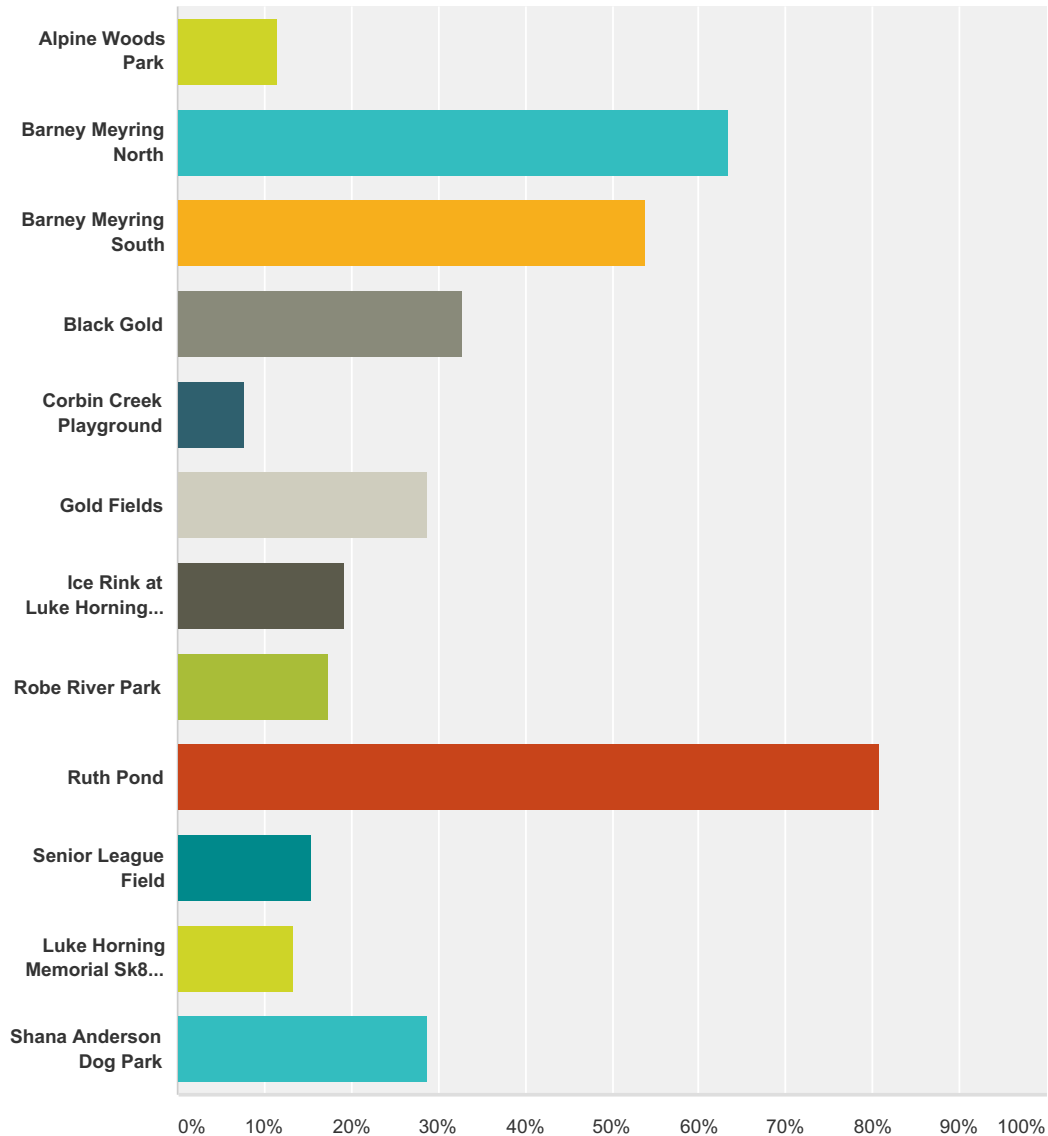

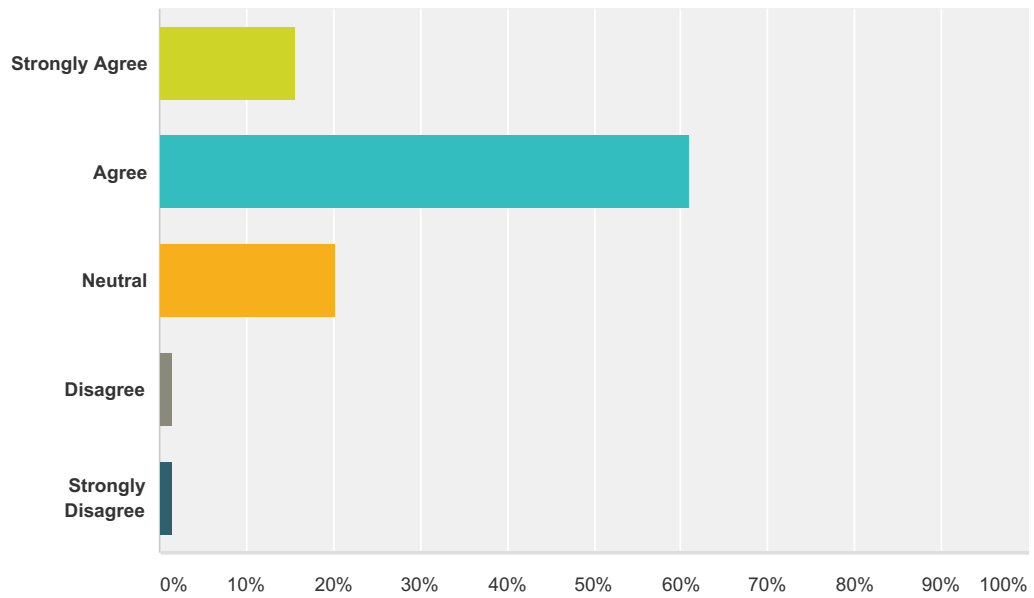

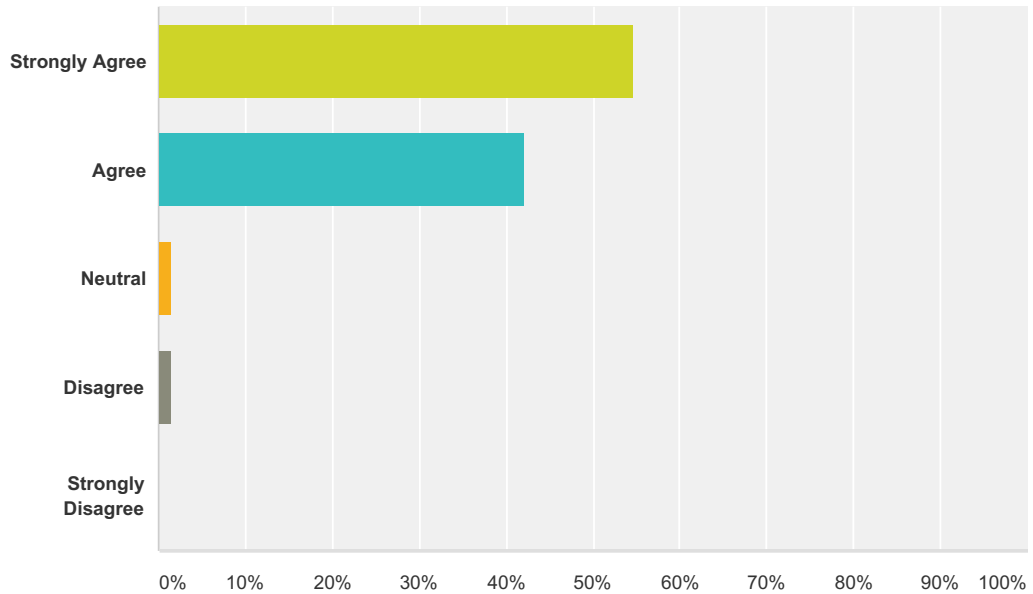

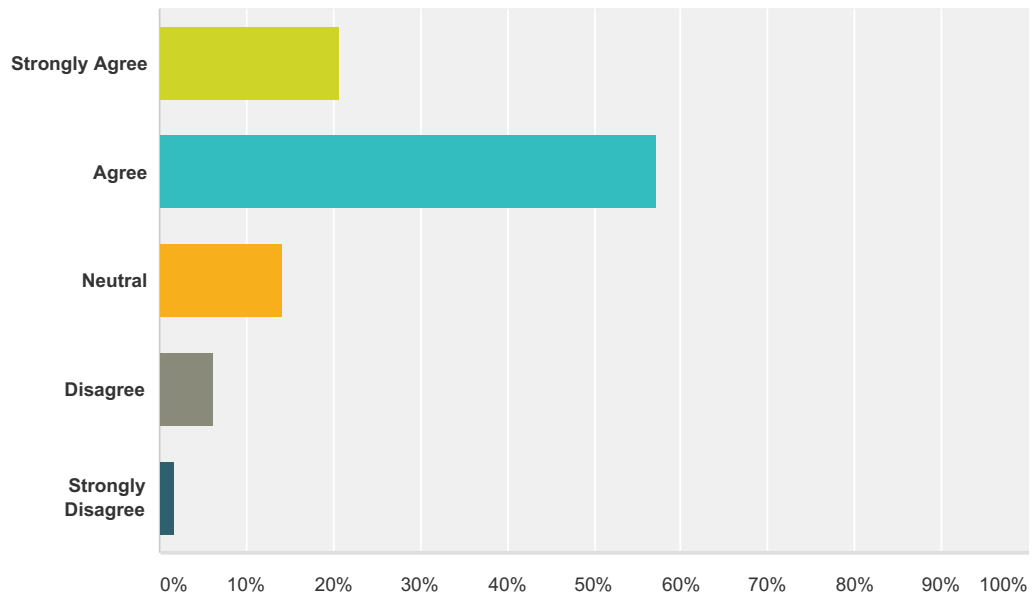

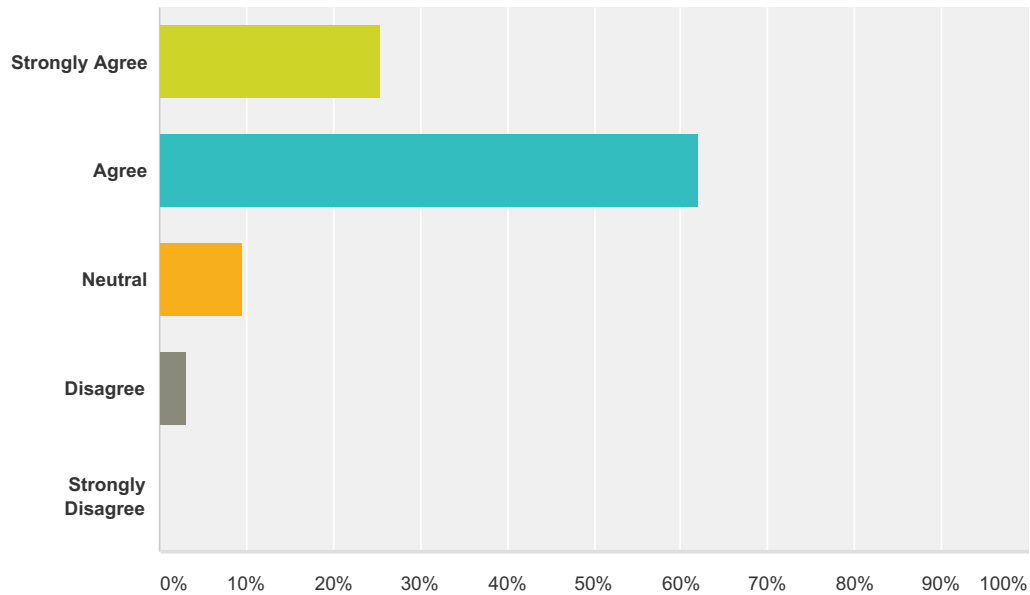

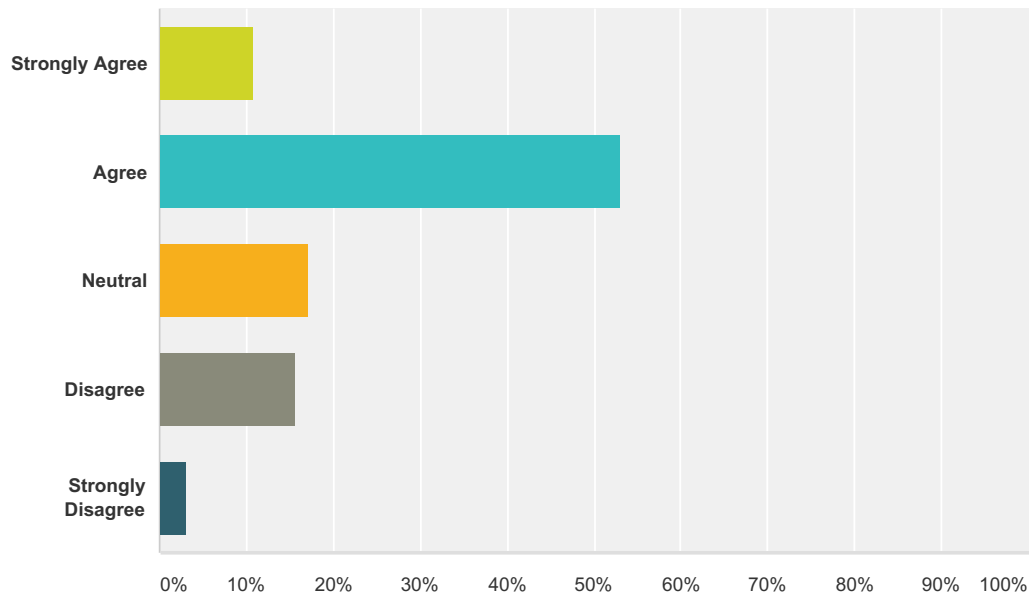

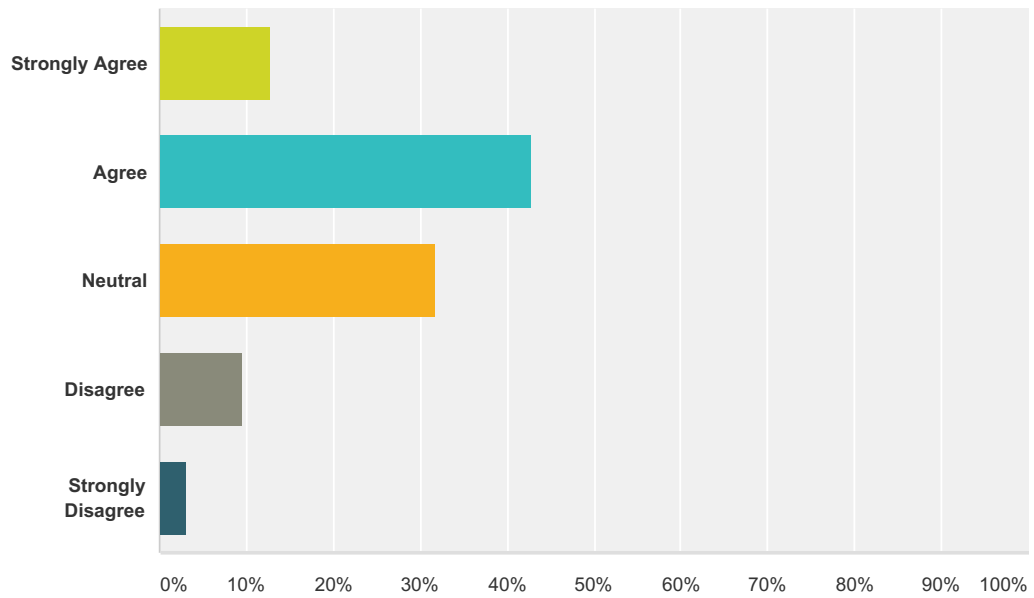

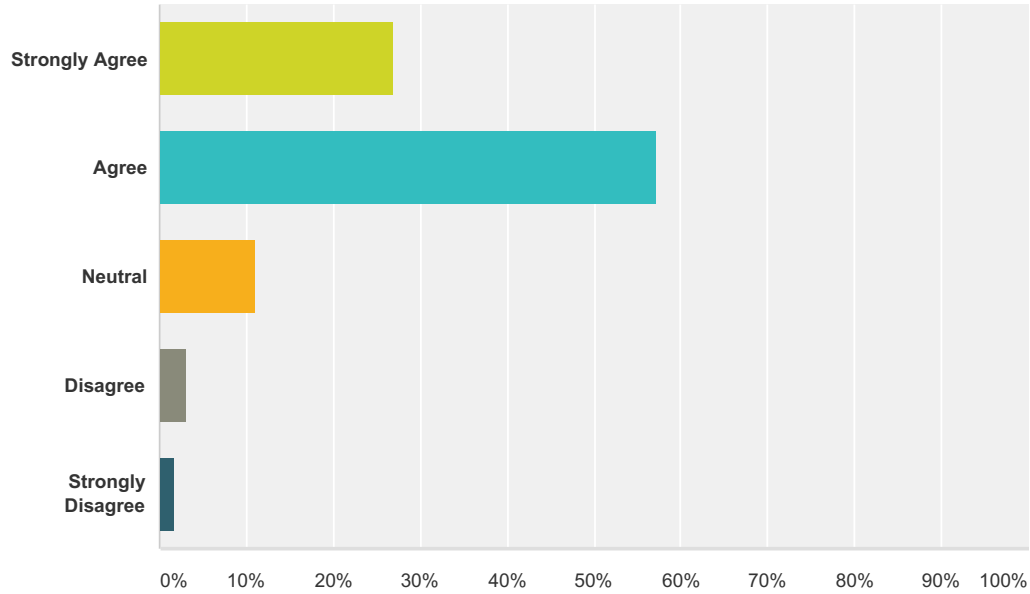

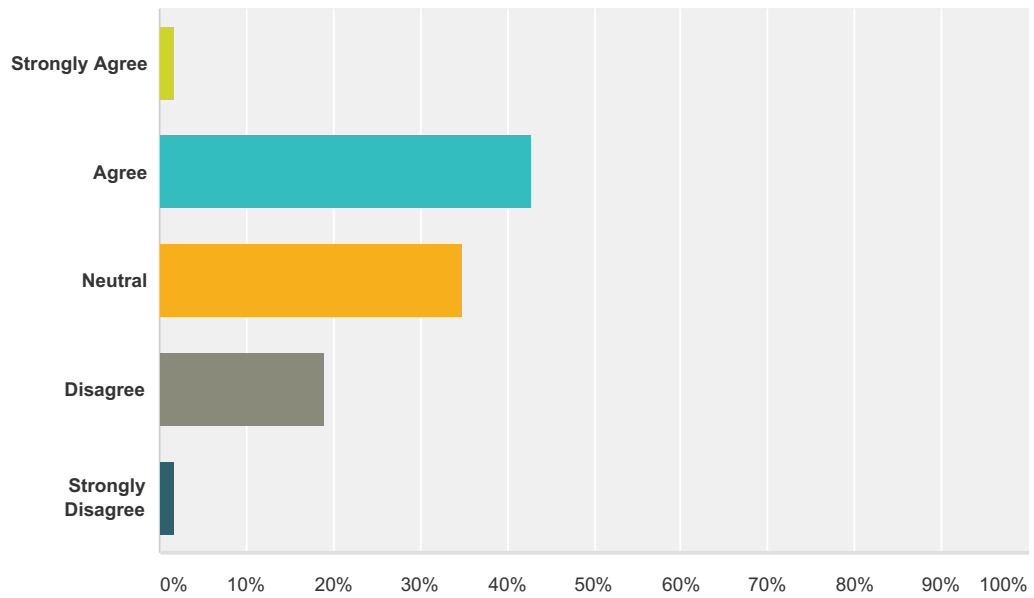

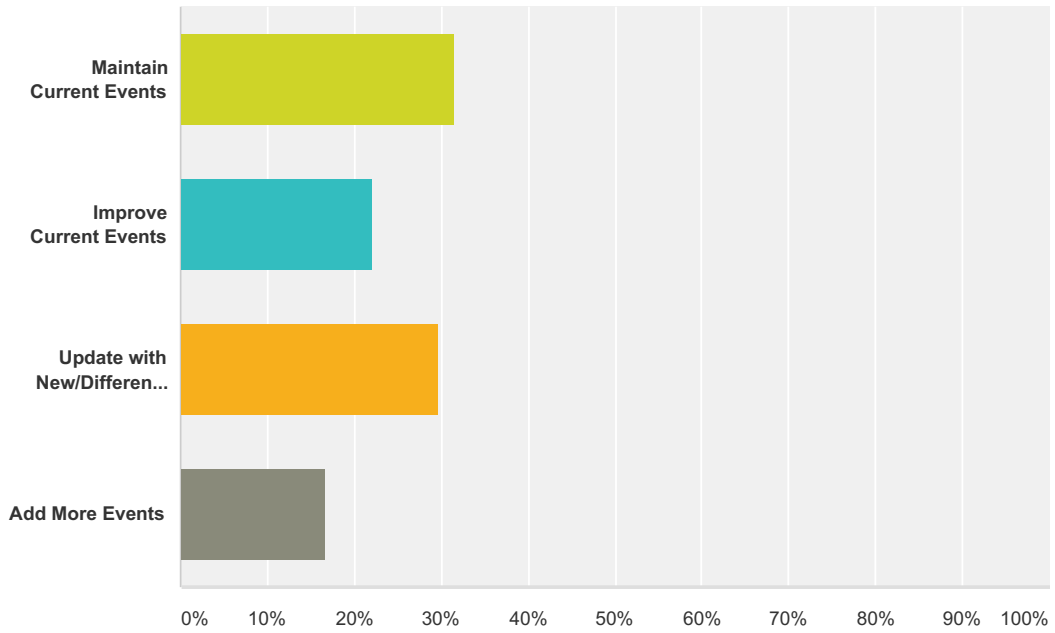

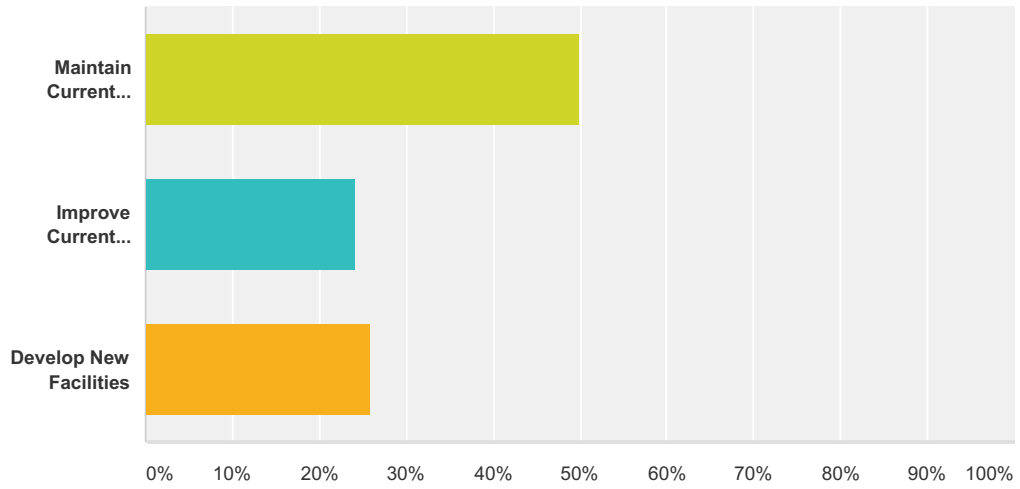

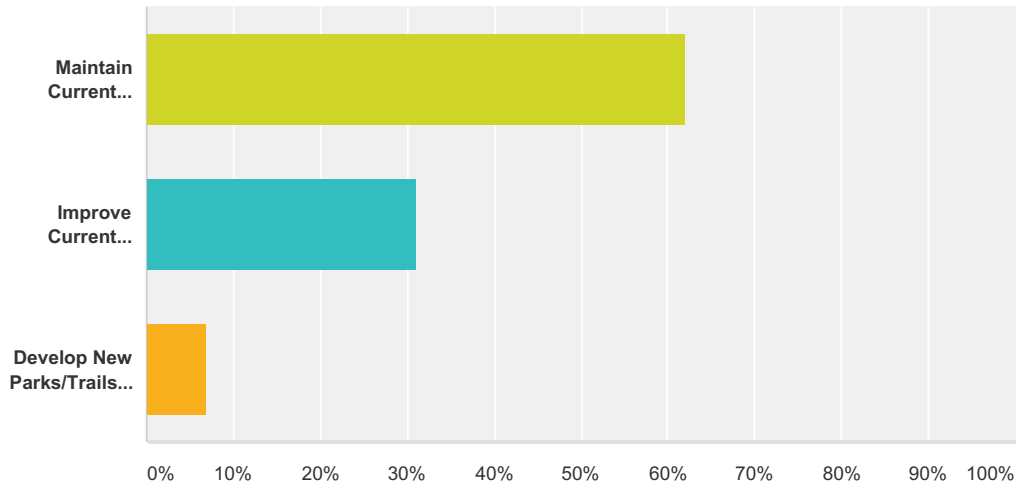
