Ski Trails: Ski trails continued to be groomed when the winds died down enough to do so. Flying tree limbs and debris covered much of the trails.

Mayors Cup: Finding enough snow for the mayors cup was difficult in the riverbed following the 3 weeks of high winds. The snowmachine club members scouted out a riverbed trail to be groomed and we were able to make a modified route.

Frosty Fever event prep: Grooming for the Giant Ski Races, The Mayors Cup, the fat tire bike races and the 120 snow machine races kept us busy.

Tower Drop built and installed: The new tower was put together and some design modifications were made prior to putting it up at Ruth Pond.

Training: Our Assistant Park Maintenance Supervisor, Canyon Rohrer completed the Certified Playground Safety Inspectors course this month and will put the training to use this summer while installing the new playground at the Shoup Bay trailhead area.
