## **RECOMMENDATION:**

Approve multiple change orders to Dawson Construction for the Gilson Middle School Project in the amount of \$82,541.89.

## **SUMMARY STATEMENT:**

The following list of Change Order items (see table on following page) is for work completed after Owner-occupancy of the Middle School facility. Each of these items was requested by City and/or School staff, though the approval of these items did not follow the formal approval process that had been previously established for the project. This issue was exacerbated by the turnover of the City Manager position and replacement of the City's Construction Manager with Arcadis. As such, staff recommends Council approval of these change order items for work that is already completed with the understanding that each item was indeed authorized by a representative of the City and/or School staff. Staff has inspected each of these items and determined they are complete to our satisfaction. Extensive documentation of these change order items is provided within this Council package given the delay associated with formal approval, turnover of staff, and staff's verification of the work such that no remaining issues are associated with each of these items.

It is worth noting that a credit on the order of \$400K, give or take, will be provided by the Contractor upon final closeout of this project in the coming months.
