

SNOW STORAGE AGREEMENT AMENDMENT NO. 1

CITY OF VALDEZ

AND

THE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

THIS AMENDMENT NO. 1 to the Snow Storage Agreement dated January 1, 2017 ("Snow Storage Agreement") is made between the City of Valdez, P.O. Box 307, Valdez, Alaska 99686, a municipal corporation organized under the laws of the State of Alaska (hereinafter referred to as "City") and the State of Alaska Department of Transportation (hereinafter referred to as "State") on the ___ day of January 2019.

WHEREAS, the City and the State entered into a Snow Storage Agreement on January 1, 2017 for a term of five years.

WHEREAS, the City and State desire to amend the Snow Storage Agreement to alter the designated areas provided for snow storage.

NOW, THEREFORE, the CITY and STATE agree as follows:

Section 1. The legal description of the areas designated for snow storage by the State is amended as follows:

The area to be provided to the State by the City consists of an area of approximate dimensions of 348 feet by 288 feet on the below described property:

Block 5 of Block 20, Mineral Creek Subdivision, Addition No. 2; and

An area of approximate dimensions of 140 feet by 91 feet on the below described property:

Block 6, Block 20, Mineral Creek Subdivision

The specific area of the above described property will be designated and marked by the State upon the approval of Public Works Director.
