# THE TEN COMMANDMENTS OF GUN SAFETY

1. Always keep the gun's muzzle pointed in a safe direction in which an accidental discharge will not injure yourself, others, or damage property. Never point your gun at anything you do not aim to shoot.
2. Always keep your finger off the trigger until you are ready to shoot. Avoid touching the trigger until the gun is pointed at an appropriate target.
3. Always keep the gun unloaded until it's ready to use. Always check the gun's magazine and chamber to see if there is no ammunition before handing over a firearm or handling it yourself. In all cases, treat the gun as if it were loaded.
4. Have the gun professionally checked to ensure that it's safe to operate.
5. Familiarize yourself with gun safety procedures with supplied instruction manuals. Be sure you know the safe way to load and unload a firearm. If you've lost your manual, then write to the manufacturer for another one. It's free!
6. Use only the correct ammunition for the gun. Information is provided will be provided on the firearm's instruction manual.
7. Know your target and what is beyond it.
8. Wear eye and ear protection as appropriate. Good eyewear is a must, as you cannot replace your eyes. Since gunshots typically exceed a volume over 90 decibels and affects hearing, ear protection is imperative as well.
9. Never use alcohol or drugs before or while shooting.
10. Store guns unloaded and make sure that they are not accessible to unauthorized users. Take special care to keep guns away from children and those unfamiliar with guns. Always let them know that they may only handle a firearm with your supervision. If children are in an environment where they are exposed to guns, provide instructions on gun safety habits, but keep the guns locked safely away.
