RE: Alaskan Greenery Limited Marijuana Cultivation Facility License Renewal

DATE: August 27th, 2019

On August 27th, 2019, I received a Limited Marijuana Cultivation Facility License Renewal for Alaskan Greenery. I contacted the owner of the business, Michael Liljedahl, who informed me that his license was approved to move from a “Standard” cultivation facility to a “Limited” cultivation facility. This matter was brought before Council earlier this summer (7/2/19 agenda) for their approval.

Having recently inspected the premises of Alaskan Greenery, and spoken at length with Mr. Liljedahl, I feel comfortable writing this memorandum of non-objection without another inspection.

As I have documented in recent years, Mr. Liljedahl appears to operate Alaskan Greenery with the utmost professionalism and openly values the partnership between his business, the State of Alaska, City of Valdez, Valdez Police Department, and the Valdez City Council. I have personally conducted multiple inspections of his business and observed his business to not only be well within the legal guidelines, but prospering and moving forward. The State of Alaska [AMCO] has conducted inspections as well. They have not provided me with any notice of violation for Alaskan Greenery.

In summary, I have no reasonable grounds to contest or deny this license renewal application.
