4. What was previous grant funding used for? Be specific.

Purchasing food to distribute to the community, which includes freight cost. Building maintenance to provide proper storage and a distribution center. Insurance, administrative, equipment repair and replace are also expenses associated with distribution. These are the main uses of the grant funding. In addition we provide emergency monetary assistance which includes, rent, electric, heating, prescription medication, and some medical. This assistance prevents evictions, unnecessary health crisis (due to loss of medication) and other negative life events. We have noted an increase in emergency requests this year, which is why we increased the budget. We also use the funding for the Backpack Buddies program in the Valdez School District. This prevents school age children from going without food for the weekend. In cooperation with the Senior Center, we provide bags of staple foods to our local Seniors. Without the assistance of the City of Valdez the food insecurity in our community would increase. The local support, volunteers, churches and organizations help make our work possible. The many volunteers, who pack bags, serve at distribution, stock shelves and clean the facility are essential. Financial support is also essential. These grant monies allow us to provide the basic food staples to clients who suffer from food insecurity and through emergency assistance to help prevent a further decent into crisis. Thank you for your continued support.
