4. What was previous grant funding used for? Be specific.

Our previous grant funding has been used in a number of ways. Grant funds have been used to purchase food for distribution and pay the freight costs of getting the food to Valdez, building maintenance to provide proper storage and a suitable distribution center, and all expenses associated with distribution. Additionally, we provide emergency monetary assistance which can include rent and utility assistance, help in affording prescription medication, and some medical costs. This assistance prevents evictions, unnecessary health crisis due to lack of access to care or medication, and other negative life events. In recent years we have seen an increase in emergency assistance requests thus the increased budget. A portion of our funds also go towards the Backpack Buddies program in the Valdez City School District. The purpose of that program is to provide food for children in need on the weekends when they do not have access to meals at school like they would on week days. In cooperation with the Valdez Senior Center we provide bags of staple foods to our local seniors. Without the assistance of the City of Valdez food insecurity in our community would increase. The support of local businesses, community volunteers, churches, and other Valdez based agencies makes the work that we do possible. The many volunteers who work tirelessly to stock shelves, package bags, serve at distribution, and help keep our facility clean are one of the main reasons we are successful, but financial support is also crucial to our operations. This grant money would allow us to ensure the basic food staples to clients who suffer from food insecurity. We are deeply grateful to the City of Valdez for their continued support.

The Valdez Food Bank and Emergency Assistance program provides food and emergency assistance to individuals and families in Valdez. The funding requested would be used to purchase food and support food distribution costs.

2. Briefly, but specifically, describe why the program to be funded under this proposal is needed and how it will benefit the Valdez community. Is this a new or existing program? How have you determined the need for your program?

This is a longstanding and crucial program in the community of Valdez. Receiving funds from this grant would ensure that we as an agency can continue to distribute food to those experiencing food insecurity. COVID-19 has strained the Food Bank's resources and increased the number of community members we serve. Taking into consideration the reality that unemployment checks are diminishing, PFD's have been distributed for the year, and another stimulus check is not guaranteed we are bracing for even more of an increase of people needing food assistance. We anticipate a high volume of participants from now until well into the COVID-19 recovery process. With COVID-19 lasting an unknown amount of time it is imperative that the Food Bank be prepared to serve an increasing number of people in Valdez for the foreseeable future.

The Food Bank is run entirely off of a volunteer base. Community members, churches, the United States Coast Guard, local businesses, Valdez City Schools, and a number of other people, agencies, and organizations join the Food Bank board to ensure the Food Bank remains operational and able to service Valdez.

Types of services provided by volunteers:

Volunteers are essential to our organization. They order food, accept deliveries, accept and weigh in donated food, inspect all food for expiration dates, stock shelves, update computers, clean, repackage bulk foods, prepackage bags for distribution and senior bag deliveries, keep records, staff distribution, pre-bag food for curbside distribution, and a number of other tasks.

10. Where will you operate this program? What facilities?

The Emergency Assistance and Food Bank of Valdez will continue to operate out of the Food Bank building located on the Richardson highway next to the Valdez Animal Shelter.

11. What is the specific impact on your program if City funding is available at the following percentages of your request?

75% We would have to seek donations from other sources.

This organization is an essential program for the community of Valdez. We live in a community with a high cost of food. Many of our clients are employed but still experiencing food insecurity. Without this agency families in transition, people in the midst of medical emergencies, seniors, people with disabilities, and those suffering from unemployment would go hungry without our services. Beyond just feeding people we help to ensure that people can remain in their homes with our emergency assistance program.

We deeply appreciate the City of Valdez's steady support to the Food Bank and all of the support we receive from our volunteers that work tirelessly to keep us operational.

At this time we are a working board, but we are in the process of hiring a program coordinator. Having one paid employee will increase the efficiency of the Food Bank, but will allow us to continue operating at a low cost and use our funds to provide for those that need our support.

In 2021 we would like to alleviate hunger and give members of our community access to nutritious foods in Valdez.

1. Provide an adequate number of distribution opportunities of food each month to lower income adults, children, and seniors.
2. Fund the Backpack Buddies program for school age children's weekend basic food needs.
3. Provide TEFAP storage and distribution (FDA foods) to qualifying families and individuals.
4. Provide emergency assistance for members of the community.

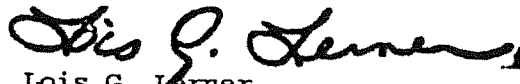
