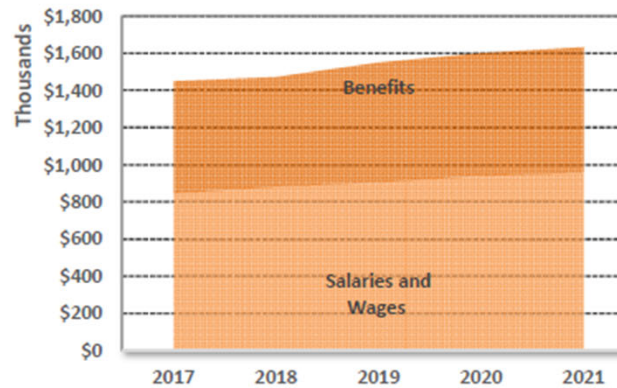

It is the mission of the City of Valdez Fire Department to provide protection of life, property, and the environment from the effects of fires, medical emergencies, and hazards.

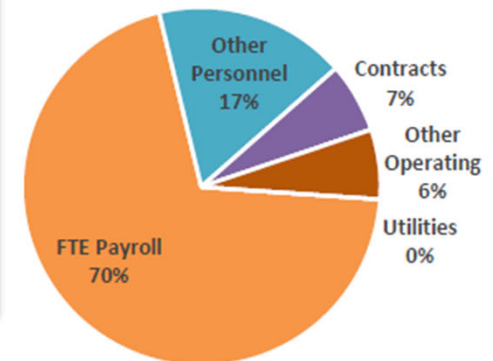

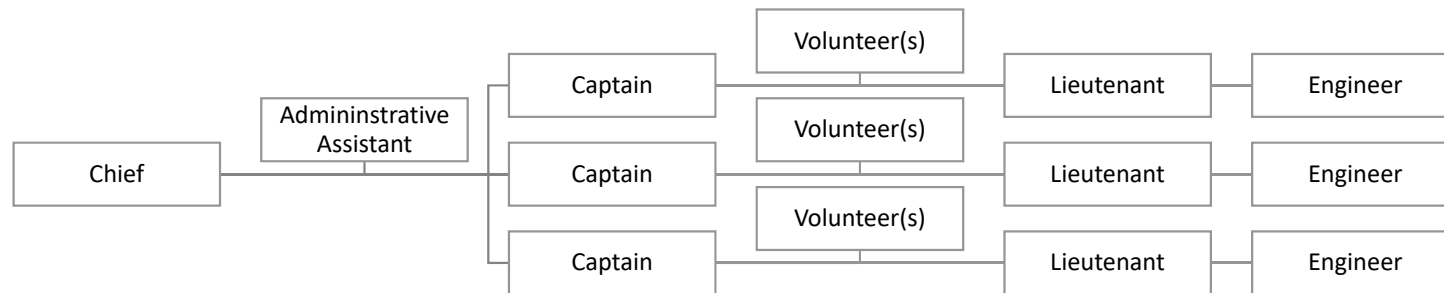
