




# Organizational Chart

    - 3 staff assigned to each shift
    - Minimum staffing is 2 per shift
  - Volunteers
    - Currently 28 Volunteers
    - Target 45 Volunteers
  - Major Equipment
    - Rolling Stock
  - Other Major Equipment
