### **SUMMARY STATEMENT:**

The city has received notification from the Alaska Alcoholic Beverage Control Board on a request for transfer of controlling interest for the package store license Safeway dba Oaken Keg. If a protest is filed, the board will deny the application unless the board finds that the protest is

arbitrary, capricious, and unreasonable.
