Medical Center capital and maintenance projects.

- All currently appropriated PVMC project funds have been provided from PVMC reserves via cash transfer to the City.
- Staff and PVMC anticipate that this funding convention will be ongoing.
- Staff recommends isolating these funds so as to prevent commingling of hospital and city funds as projects are periodically closed or re-prioritized.
